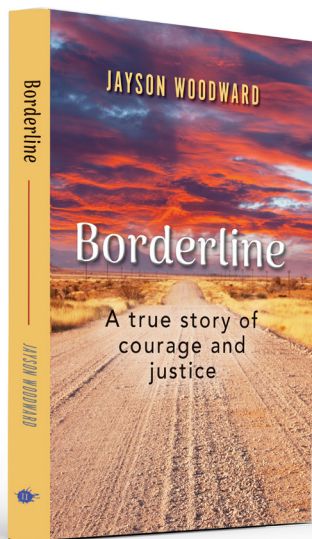

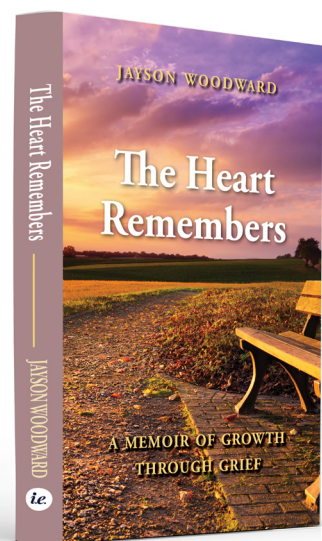
## **The Heart Remembers**
